TEMPERAMENT TRAINING PLAN

NAME: MAC LITTER: ROASTED WITH LOVE DATE: 8/25/2024

Mac is an energetic and affectionate puppy who exhibits a curious and friendly temperament. He loves exploring new environments and engaging with both people and other animals, showcasing his sociable and adaptable nature. This temperament test is a valuable tool to guide his training by highlighting his strengths and areas where he may need extra support. Remember, as Mac grows older and experiences different environments, his personality and behavior will continue to evolve. Utilizing positive reinforcement techniques will not only strengthen your bond with Mac but also encourage desirable behaviors, making training an enjoyable and effective experience for both of you.

TRAIT TRAINING PLAN

ENERGY LEVEL	Provide Mac with mental stimulating toys (brain games) throughout the day to help from him getting bored. Kongs, puzzles, lick mats, food puzzles are great options.
TOUCH TOLERANCE	Continue to desensitize to various handling. Trim nails weekly with fingernail clippers and round them off using a quiet dremel (I recommend PupWells dremel as it super quiet).
PATIENCE	To teach Mac patience, start by incorporating short waiting periods during play and mealtime, gradually increasing the duration as he learns to wait calmly for rewards and attention.
SETTLE	To help Mac learn to settle and relax, start by teaching him to go to a designated spot, such as a bed or mat, using positive reinforcement. Gradually increase the duration of time he stays there, rewarding him for calm behavior and gently redirecting him if he becomes restless.
OVERSTIMULATION	To help Mac avoid overstimulation, use the crate as a calming space by placing high-value rewards inside. Gradually increase the time he spends in the crate with the rewards, reinforcing calm behavior and using the crate as a retreat from overstimulating situations.

Start Mac's training sessions in a quiet, familiar environment to minimize distractions. Use high-value treats and plenty of verbal praise to reward his desired behaviors. Begin with short, frequent training sessions, gradually increasing their length as Mac's attention span develops. Be consistent with cues and commands, and always end sessions on a positive note. If Mac shows signs of stress or discomfort, take a step back and return to a simpler task that he can easily accomplish to build his confidence. Remember, patience and consistency are key in helping Mac develop into a well-mannered and confident adult dog.
